































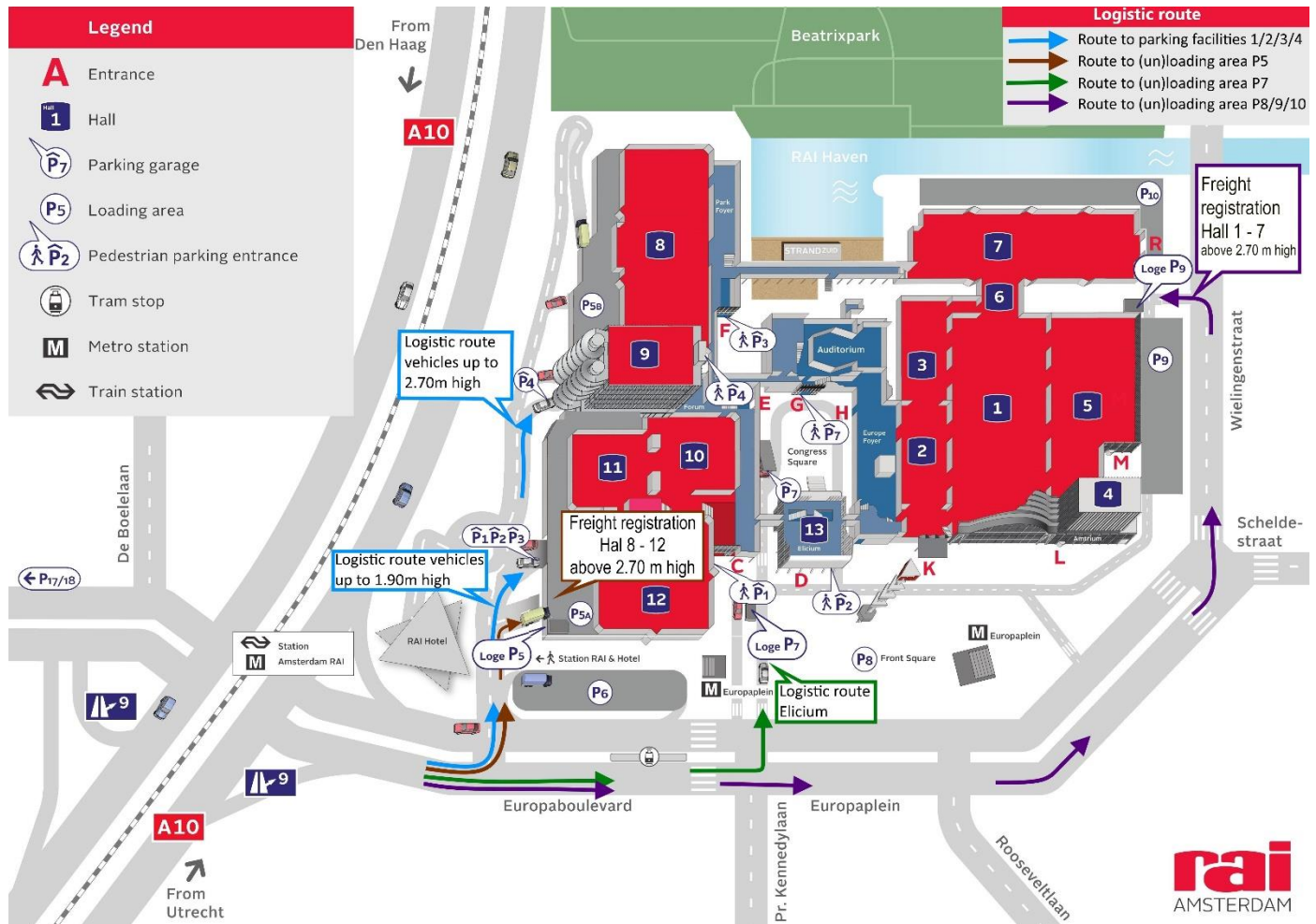
Vehicles up to 2.70 m high are not allowed on loading areas P5, P7, P8, P9 and P10, due to limited outside space on the loading areas.
