

Specific Terms & Conditions Aquatech China 2020

These specific Terms and Conditions for Event Participation (The Specific Event Terms) apply to participation in Aquatech China 2020 (the Event) In addition to these Specific Event Terms, the General Terms and Conditions of Event Participation (the General Event Terms) also apply. Terms in these Specific Event Terms with a capital letter have the same definitions given to them in the General Event Terms.

Venue and dates

The exhibition will be held in hall 1.2, 2.2, 8.1 & 8.2 of National Exhibition and Convention Center, No.333, Songze Avenue, Shanghai, China from Monday 31 August up to and including Wednesday 2 September 2020.

Opening hours

The exhibition will be open to visitors on:

Monday 31 August 2020	09.00 A.M. – 05.00 P.M.
Tuesday 1 September 2020	09.00 A.M. – 05.00 P.M.
Wednesday 2 September 2020	09.00 A.M. – 03.00 P.M.

For exhibitors, the building will be accessible from 30 minutes before the opening until 30 minutes after the closing of the exhibition.

Construction and dismantling period

The hall will be open for stand construction and preparation on Saturday 29 August to Sunday 30 August 2020 from 08.30 A.M. to 05.30 P.M. The exhibits may be removed and the stands dismantled and taken away on Wednesday 2 September, from 03:30 P.M.

Admission

There will be no basic admission charge as referred to in Clause 2 of the General Rules. Visitors who register online or onsite can enter the Exhibition free of charge.

Event programme

Products and services are only authorised for display at the Event if, in the opinion of RAI, they conform the scope of the Event. Authorisation is at the full discretion of RAI, or any committee designated by RAI.

Participants

Participants may be manufacturers, representatives, importers, wholesalers, exporters, publishing companies and other service providers, as long as they are economically active in the field of Water Treatment, Transport & Storage, Point of Use and Process control technology & process automation. Authorisation is at the full discretion of the organisers, who may refuse exhibitors without incurring any liability.

Demonstrations

Special activities at stands, such as product presentations, performances and shows, may only take place if written permission is granted by RAI. Please note that permission must be requested in writing at the latest 30 days before the beginning of the construction period. This permission is subject to various conditions, including that the activity must be situated in such a way that interested visitors do not block the corridor.

Costs of Stand Space

The rental price per square meter of floor space is:

Municipal & Industrial segments:

- Deluxe Zone: \$306,00 when booked before 1 Dec 2019, \$ 340,00 regular rate
- Premium Zone:\$399,33 when booked before 1 Dec 2019, \$ 443,70 regular rate

Residential/POU segments:

- Deluxe Zone: \$314,67 when booked before 1 Dec 2019, \$ 349,63 regular rate
- Premium Zone:\$405,33 when booked before 1 Dec 2019, \$ 450,37regular rate

Shell scheme construction

The above-mentioned rental fee per square metre of floor space excludes the cost of shell scheme stand construction. Participants who do not wish to construct their own stand may order shell scheme stand construction, thus saving labour and costs of transport etc.. We offer 2 different types of shell scheme construction: Deluxe and Premium shell scheme stand. For prices and all further information please refer to the application form of Aquatech China 2020. Deluxe shell scheme cannot be ordered in Premium Zone locations. Participants who do not wish to use shell scheme stand construction must ensure that their stand is in accordance with the stand build-up rules as provided in the Exhibitors Portal.

* For all stand spaces of 15 m2 and smaller the use of at least a **Deluxe shell scheme stand** from the organisers is **mandatory**.

Terms of Payment

The participation costs should be paid in accordance with the provisions of article 7 of the Standard Terms and Conditions of Event Participation.

The Participant shall have the right to cancel the Participation Agreement, free of charge, until payment of the 1st invoice is due as set out in the relevant invoice ,usually 21 days (the Cancellation Term).

The Participation Agreement may be cancelled during the Cancellation Term by sending an email to RAI at the email address specified in the Specific Event Terms. After the Cancellation Term, the Participation Agreement may only be terminated subject to payment the cancellation fee set out in article 3 in the Standard Terms.

Disputes

Any complaints should be made within 30 days of the last day of the exhibition. Complaints brought to our attention beyond this deadline will not be addressed.
